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**WebQuest Description:** This WebQuest was designed as a tool for students so that they are able to interact, share and practice their English.

**Grade Level:** 6-8

**Curriculum:** English / Language Arts

**Keywords:** reading, problem

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### Introduction

What is Reading?"Reading" is the process of looking at a series of written symbols and getting meaning from them. When we read, we use our eyes to receive written symbols (letters, punctuation marks and spaces) and we use our brain to convert them into words, sentences and paragraphs that communicate something to us. Reading can be silent (in our head) or aloud (so that other people can hear). Reading is a receptive skill - through it we receive information. But the complex process of reading also requires the skill of speaking, so that we can pronounce the words that we read. In this sense, reading is also a productive skill in that we are both receiving information and transmitting it (even if only to ourselves). Questions 1. How to solve you problems?&nbsp;

### Tasks

I have a video clip about problem for the students to watch to see that everybody has his own different problems. For the task, students have to read three stories: 1. Too many problems 2. Tired all the time 3. Don't be fat After reading, students have to answer the questions from the stories for assignment, each story have five questions and the teacher will keep the scores from these.

### Process

1. Students watch a video clip 'Milky Surprise'.
2. Students discuss about their own problems.
3. Students read the stories on the task page.
  - 1.) Too many problems
  - 2.) Tired all the time
  - 3.) Don't be fat
- &nbsp;4. Students answer the questions from the stories.
- &nbsp;5. Students get scores from answering the questions.
