If you need help, ask a team member or the Media Center staff.Step #1: Remind GroupsPlease join our class Remind Alerts for information and homework reminders. It is required you join, but don't worry, I won't send out very many messages. To pull up your class remind code (this is different from the summer code), click here. Next, join the Southeast Raleigh Magnet school announcements, which will be sent during 2nd period daily. It is important you read these as well! Click here for this code. Step #2: Tell Me About YOU! Take some time to fill out this student survey for me. I do read these, everything helps me understand your needs better! Make sure to include any IEP information you have when it asks for it. Step #3: Check You GradesLogin to your Powerschools and check your grades! If you don't know the web address to check email or grades, go to our schools website and then scroll towards the bottom to the blue area that says "Quick Links". Choose Student Powerschools from that list. If you don't know your password, go get it reset with one of the Media Center staff members to reset it for you. Step #4: Setup College Board AccountMake sure you have setup and remember your College Board account. Counselors will send out more info when it is time to register for exams. Remember taxpayers are now paying your fee to take these tests! Yay, taxpayers! Once you are logged in, spend some time browsing this site, putting the various AP testing days and times in your calendar. Online Exam registration will begin on Mon, Nov 26, 2018 at 8:00 AM and end on Tue, Feb 26, 2019 at 8:00 AM.Step #5: Collaborate to Finish VocabularyAccess the APUSH 1st Semester Team Drive and "Terms To Know" folder that will contain a spreadsheet where your class will fill out information for all Vocabulary Terms for all 9 Time Periods. To access this, use your student email address login and go to Google Drive. For this week, you should add Period 1 and Period 2 terms to the document you create.
